In addition to the standard required information, International students must also submit:

- **TOEFL** (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or **IELTS** (International English Language Testing System) Scores are required if English is not your native language. A minimum score of 550 (paper-based exam), 80 (internet-based exam) or 213 (computer-based exam) is recommended for TOEFL. A score of 7 or higher is recommended for the IELTS.
- Completed **Affidavit of Support Forms**: These forms can be found in the International Student Admission Handbook on the International Student Applicant website (below)..
- **Financial Information Form**: Also included in the International Student Admission Handbook, this form verifies full funding for your education. *Note that financial aid and scholarships are not available to international students.*
- **Transcripts**: Applicants are required to submit ALL Transcripts. In most cases, transcripts must be submitted to a United States agency that provides foreign credential evaluations before being sent to TCNJ.
- **Doctor's Certification**: This certification is used to determine if you are in good health and have had your vaccinations.
- A **WASC Transcript** if you are an applicant from West Africa.
